April brought with it a number of important safety campaigns:


National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week (April 13-19) featured videos of dispatchers that were deployed on Thruway social media channels.

The CSEA Local 058 2025 Election committee would like to let everyone know the election cycle has been in full swing since it's kick off March 31st. As many of you are already aware, on that date the election schedule, information regarding running for a position and rules of campaigning were posted on bulletin boards and e-mailed to your personal email.

This is a good time to remind everyone to keep their personal contact info (home address and email) with CSEA up to date. Work e-mails cannot be used for union activity, so having this info up to date is critical to you receiving election info.

Recently you may have been approached or heard about incumbents and potential candidates seeking signatures for their petitions to secure a place on the ballot.

That step was completed on May 1st, which happened to coincide with May Day / Labour Day. A day known and celebrated globally by 160 countries to commemorates the historic struggles and gains made by the labour movement with its origins rooted in America. Specifically 1886 Chicago. If you are interested in history and the labour movement, I encourage you to read about it.

In the coming weeks the election committee will be printing and mailing ballots to your homes for voting.
